Planetarium at the Faculty of Science and Technology, Jan Dlugosz University in Czestochowa, Polish Association for Astronomy Enthusiasts- Priest Bonawentura Metler's Unit in Częstochowa and Space Conquerors Primary School no.1 in Czestochowa invite you to participate in the next edition of the International Art and Photography Competition "Astronomia Art" under the honorary patronage of the Rector of Jan Dlugosz University in Czestochowa, Professor Anna Wypych-Gawrońska, Ph.D.

1. Organizers of the competition:

2. Aims of the competition:

- popularization of natural sciences and arousing interest in astronomy,
- raising sensitivity to the beauty of nature and learning how to observe astronomical phenomena,
- shaping competitors' imagination as well as their aesthetic sensitivity through promoting various forms of fine arts,
- developing artistic talents,
- presenting artistic creativity of children.

3. Competition's recipients

The competition is dedicated to primary and secondary school students. They are divided into three age categories:

- grades 1-3,
- grades 4-6,
- grades 7-8,
- secondary school.

4. Rules for participation:

- Participation in the competition is free.
- The competition works should refer to astronomy.
- Participants are allowed to submit a maximum of two competition entries.

5. Competition entries sizes and techniques:

2D ENTRIES- painting, drawing, graphics (including computer graphics)- size not bigger than 50 x 70 cm

3D ENTRIES- any technique- the entry should fit into a cube with a side of 50 cm. All elements should be permanently attached. Do not send the entries made of bulk material.

PHOTOGRAPHS: the possible sizes of photographs are 30x30cm, 30x40cm and 30x45cm.

5.Sending competition works:

A student or a teacher should attach a label to the back of the competition entry (attachement 2), together with a consent to the processing of personal data (attachements 1). The label should be affixed to the back of the competition entry and completed in capital letters.

It contains:

- -participant's first name and surname,
- -title of a competition entry,
- -age and grade,
- -school's name, address, e-mail, phone number
- -teacher's name, surname, phone number.

The competition works should be delivered until 18th November 2022, 3 p.m. to the following address:

The artworks and photographs sent to the competition organizers become the property of Planetarium at the Faculty of Science and Technology, Jan Dlugosz University in Czestochowa. They are allowed to display the competition entries anywhere at any time. The organizers do not cover the shipping costs.

6. Competition results

Award winners will be notified and awards announced by the end of December 2022.

The selection board will include organizers who have the right to invite visual artists to evaluate the competition entries more thoroughly. The organizers also have the right to divide competitors according to their age and, depending on the artistic quality, award prizes 1-8 places separately for each of the groups. The jury is allowed to award the Grand Prix for an outstanding competition entry. The official award ceremony will be held until 28st February 2023.
